Pupils have approached us with the idea of holding a Charity Christmas Dodgeball festival in order to raise funds for CLAN and the School Fund. This will be a sponsored event, which will take place on the last day of term, WEDNESDAY 21st December, with 80% of money raised going to CLAN and 20% to the Brae High School Fund.

The Ultimate Dodgeball Tournament provides an ideal opportunity for your child to take part in a healthy, fun activity in a relaxed and enjoyable atmosphere and, at the same time, to raise valuable funding.

CLAN is an independent charity for anyone affected by any type of cancer at any time from diagnosis onwards. Whether affected personally, as a carer, family member or close friend, their services are available to you. Based at CLAN House in Aberdeen, they cover the whole of Grampian, Orkney and Shetland. The Brae High School fund is set up and used for the benefit/development of pupils and/or the school overall.

Secondary 4 pupils will be organising the festival, registration of teams of 6 (3 boys, 3 girls) across a range of year groups. Teams may have a theme, fancy dress or uniform, music to introduce their team and a team chant if they wish. Sponsorship/Donation forms will be available for pupils who wish to help raise funds. If your son/daughter is not taking part in the festival but you would like to make a donation towards this cause we would be very grateful.
